### CONTEST RULES

- 1.) Each Contestant entering the Port Washington Lions Club Fishing Derby automatically agrees to abide by all rules of the Derby and the laws of the State of Wisconsin pertaining to fishing in Lake Michigan waters.
- 2.) **The 2010 Contest begins at 4:30 AM Saturday July 31<sup>st</sup> and ends at 12:30 PM on Sunday August 1<sup>st</sup>.**
- 3.) Sale of \$20.00 Advanced Tickets will cease at 4:29 AM Saturday morning. Mail in orders must be postmarked by July 19, 2010. Tickets will be on sale at Lions Headquarters throughout the Derby for \$30.00.
- 4.) **One ticket per angler is required, (NOT one per boat). Each ticket is valid for both days.**
- 5.) To be eligible to win a prize, each ticket holder must register at least one fish per ticket number.
- 6.) To enter a fish in the Derby, the contestant must have purchased their ticket before catching the fish.
- 7.) Each entrant must have a valid Wisconsin Fishing License and a Great Lakes Salmon stamp. Under Wisconsin law anyone under 15 years of age or younger is not required to purchase a fishing license.
- 8.) All fish entered must be registered (weighed in) at the Derby Headquarters within 15 hours after they are caught. No frozen or discolored fish will be accepted.
- 9.) **Fish will be judged by weight / species. Lions Club judges and/or the Wisconsin DNR will make all determinations as to weight and species. Determination of the judges will be final in all cases. In the event of a tie for a prize, the FIRST FISH REGISTERED will be eligible for that prize.**
- 10.) Registration hours are Saturday 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM and Sunday 6:00 AM to 12:30 PM. On Sunday, anglers in line to register fish at 12:30 PM will be allowed to register their fish and will be eligible for prizes. Any one entering the line after 12:30 PM will not be able to register their fish.
- 11.) Winners need not be present to win, but must pick up their prizes within 30 days of the event. All fish must be claimed and picked up by 5:00 PM Sunday evening. Those fish not claimed will be donated to charity and are not the responsibility of the Port Washington Lions Club.
- 12.) The Port Washington Lions Club assumes no responsibility or liability for any accident or injury to anyone participating in the Port Washington Lions Club Fishing Derby, nor any liability for any lost or stolen articles during this event.

### FISHING BOUNDARIES

**Boundaries will be as far south as Ozaukee County and as far north as Sheboygan County.** These boundaries are not patrolled but should be followed. The Port Washington Lions Club is a non-profit organization and hopes that all contestants follow the spirit of the rules.

### THIS DERBY'S (5) FISH CATEGORIES

COHO SALMON - CHINOOK SALMON  
RAINBOW TROUT - LAKE TROUT - BROWN TROUT

An additional prize will be awarded for a Derby record fish caught by a registrant during the event.

### PRIZES AND CONTEST GRAND PRIZE

**There is a guaranteed Grand Prize of \$1,500 Cash.** The Grand Prize will be awarded from a drawing of the winners of the largest fish, by weight, caught and weighed during the Derby in our categories. The Grand Prize winner will NOT receive the \$300 Category Prize.

### CATEGORY PRIZES

Guaranteed Prizes of \$300 Cash will be given for the largest fish (by weight) caught in each of the remaining 4 species categories. \$200 Cash will be awarded for 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, \$100 Cash for 3<sup>rd</sup>, and \$50 Cash for 4<sup>th</sup> place in each of the five categories.

### CONFIRMATION OF ELIGIBILITY

The Port Washington Lions Club reserves the right to confirm contestant's eligibility by internal inspection (gutting) of all prize-winning entries or by requesting contestants to submit to a lie detector test.

### COMMUNITY AND INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS

Proceeds from all Port Washington Lions Club projects have been used to fill community needs. Donations have been made to several local Park Projects including Lions Park, Veterans Park and the Lions Shelter on the upper Bluff, Portal Programs, Two Port Washington Harbor Fish Cleaning Stations, Our local Food Pantry, Annual PWHS Awards Banquet, the Badger Boys and Girls State, and Handicapped youth to Lions Camp Rosholt.
